

III. CONDUCT RULES AND REGULATIONS: ATTENDANCE-

Students have to attend at least 75% of regular classes in each subject/Paper to sit for End Semester Examinations (ESE) conducted in May and November.

Attendance will be calculated by taking an aggregate of attendance of the students in all their subjects.

A student found absent for more than 15 days at a stretch, without informing the concerned authorities, will be removed from the attendance roll.

Students do not have any leave entitlement.

USE OF INTOXICANTS

Smoking is strictly prohibited in the college. Any student found smoking in the college campus is liable to pay a fine of Rs.200.

The use of alcohol and other intoxicants is strictly prohibited within the college premises and during College functions elsewhere. Any student found indulging in this will have to leave the College.
